Dear Parents, Guardians, and Friends of Eastwood High School Students,

The Junior Class is proud to announce the 2018 Junior/Senior Prom and Dinner Dance to be held Saturday, May 5, 2018, at BGSU Olscamp Hall. The evening will start promptly at 7:00 with a salute to the Class of 2018 followed by a buffet dinner. It is important that everyone arrive between 6:15 and 6:45 so no one will miss the salute and the dining experience. Students will not be admitted after 7:00. King and Queen announcements will begin at approximately 8:00. The event will end at 11pm.

Tickets will be \$45.00 per person, which includes dinner as well as refreshments to be served throughout the evening. Tickets will go on sale in the Eagle's Nest before school April 16-20. Students will not be allowed to sign up for a table unless they have bought a ticket.

All Prom participants must abide by the Eastwood High School rules for attire and behavior. We do accept the fact that formal wear by female students may be a bit more "revealing" (spaghetti straps and off-the-shoulder wear) than allowed by regular school dress policy, but it is very important that formal attire meets a standard of decency. Dresses that reveal too much of the body around the stomach, naval, lower back, and sides are not appropriate. Slits or splits in clothing must be modest. Administration and/or advisors will make a final decision on appropriateness in the way students are dressed for the Prom. Gentlemen are expected to dress in formal attire (tuxedos or suits). Any student who does not meet this standard of dress will be asked to leave the Prom. Dress is formal, and we hope all will attend.

Forms that must be completed and turned in before buying a ticket (all will be available in the office):

- Non-Eastwood Guests: Visitor Request Form and the Dance Procedure Letter Acknowledgement, which is on the back of the Visitor Request Form

In an attempt to help defray costs, the Prom Committee is selling Grand March tickets. Tickets sold in advance will be \$3 or \$5 at the door the night of Prom.

Tickets will allow parents to enter the Prom to take pictures during the Grand March. Parents with tickets will be admitted to the Prom sometime between 8:00-8:15pm to take pictures during the Grand March. No one without a ticket will be allowed to enter. Parents and guests entering the hall are expected to dress appropriately because the Prom is a formal event.

2018 Eastwood After-Prom Information/Contact Waiver

The date for the Eastwood's Junior/Senior Prom on Saturday, May 5, 2018 is quickly approaching. Our goal is to make the Drug and Alcohol Free After-Prom as enjoyable and safe as possible for all students and guests. Accomplishing this will take the commitment of many people.

The After-Prom will be held from 11:30-3:30 am on Saturday May 5 – Sunday May 6, 2018 at the Eastwood High School. Doors will open at 11:30 pm. Students and their guests must be present by 12:15 am (with the exception of those who need to clean up after the prom) or their parents will be notified. School rules will be in effect throughout the morning at the After-Prom.

This waiver form is required to be signed by every student attending the After-Prom and their parent, even if the student is planning on watching rather than actually participating in the After-Prom activities. **All high school students attending the After-Prom need to have a parent signature even if they are 18 years or older.**

This letter must be completed, signed and dated at the time the After-Prom ticket(s) are purchased. Please sign BOTH sides of this form and return it when purchasing your After-Prom ticket. Without this signed form, you will not be able to purchase a ticket Please include a phone number where the parent can be reached during the hours of 11:30 p.m. and 3:30 a.m. on May 5th and May 6th, 2018. All Eastwood students and guests will be required to stay at the After-Prom until 3:30 a.m.

Tickets will be on sale **April 16- April 20, 2018**. Tickets will be sold at the same time as Prom tickets from 7:00 a.m. until 7:45 a.m. The ticket price is \$10.00 per person. Cash or checks made payable to "Eastwood After-Prom" will be accepted. You do not need to attend prom to attend the After-Prom.

RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In consideration of participating in the activities as described below (hereinafter collectively referred to as "activities"), and for other good and valuable consideration, I hereby agree to release and discharge from liability arising from negligence, Game Craze LLC and its owners, directors, officers employees, agents, volunteers, participants, and all other persons or entities acting for them (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Releasees"), on behalf of myself and my children, parents, heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as well as any other parties that participate in the activities during the agreed rental period, and also agree as follows:

Activities: Mechanical Bull, Laser Tag, Sumo Wrestling, Bungee Run, Gladiator Jousting, and Interactive Play System.

1. I acknowledge that the activities involve known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis or permanent disability, death, and property damage. Risks include, but are not limited to broken bones, bruises and other bodily injuries caused by falls or contact with other participants; medical conditions resulting from physical activity; and damaged clothing or other property. I understand such risks simply cannot be eliminated, despite the use of safety equipment, without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.
 2. I expressly accept and assume all of the risks inherent in this activity or that might have been caused by the negligence of the Releasees. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to participate despite the risks. In addition, if at any time I believe that event conditions are unsafe or that I am unable to participate due to physical or medical conditions, then I will immediately discontinue participation.
 3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity, or my use of their equipment or facilities, arising from negligence. This release does not apply to claims arising from intentional conduct. Should Releasees or anyone acting on their behalf be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.
 4. I represent that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may suffer or cause while participating in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that I have no medical or physical condition which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume – and bear the costs of – all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.
 5. In the event that I file a lawsuit, I agree to do so solely in the state where Releasees' facility is located, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply.
 6. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.
- By signing this document, I agree that if I am hurt, then I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against the parties being released on the basis of any claim for negligence. I have had sufficient time to read this entire document and, should I choose to do so, consult with legal counsel prior to signing. Also, I understand that this activity might not be made available to me or that the cost to engage in this activity would be significantly greater if I were to choose not to sign this release, and agree that the opportunity to participate at the stated cost in return for the execution of this release is a reasonable bargain. I have read and understood this document and I agree to be bound by its terms.

1. Eastwood High School students are permitted to bring one (1) guest of high school status. Guests who have graduated from high school within the last two (2) years are permitted to attend special events such as Prom and formal Homecoming.
2. The guest student and the student's parent/guardian must complete this form and submit it to Eastwood High School at least one day in advance of the dance/activity.
3. Once you arrive to the dance/activity, you must enter the building and remain inside until you leave.
4. All guests may be asked to show his/her driver's license or ID prior to admittance.
5. Once you have left the premises, you will not be permitted to return.
6. If you arrive late or leave early, your parents may be notified.
7. There is to be no smoking at the dance/activity or on school grounds.
8. Any student or guest shall not possess, use, transmit, sell or be under the influence of any drug or alcoholic beverage of any kind either before the dance/activity, during the dance/activity, or on school property.
9. The Eastwood school administration, or their designee, reserves the right to remove any student and/or guest from the dance/activity or from school property.
10. The administration, or their designee, reserves the right to deny entrance to any student and/or guest.
11. I understand that attendance to a dance/activity at Eastwood High School is a privilege and not a right.
12. I understand that law enforcement officials and/or school officials will enforce these rules, regulations, policies, and procedures.

Dance Policy and Acknowledgement Form

In 2012, Eastwood High School adopted a new protocol in regards to our school sponsored dances, which allows for administrators and chaperones to address inappropriate forms of dancing. The Eastwood Student Handbook policy concerning dancing states:

"Club Dancing", bumping, grinding, or other forms of sexually suggestive dancing is prohibited.

The policy and this form, which has now been implemented and covers all of our dances, is as follows:

Before students can buy their tickets for the dance, they must first read and sign a Dance Policy Letter and Acknowledgement Form. When students buy their tickets, they will turn in this form with the parent's and student's signatures and receive a wristband which is their "ticket" to enter the dance. They will need to make sure that they bring and wear that wristband at the dance. If a student loses their wristband, it will cost \$2.00 to replace it.

If a student is observed dancing inappropriately, one of the school personnel/staff persons will then pull the student aside and tell them what they observed, and then the school personnel/staff person will take the student's wristband off. This will mean that the student has been warned, and if they are observed dancing inappropriately again, they will be asked to leave the dance. If a student is asked to leave the dance, the parents will be contacted to inform them of what occurred.
