The state has sent out their report cards and selected measures of effectiveness for schools across Ohio. However, we wanted to give you some real time data that really means something!

This year Eastwood is offering 11 college courses on our campus which is our highest total to date. Next year with the introduction of General Studies Writing II through BGSU, the number of classes will swell to 12. We have college coursework in math, science, political science, English, German, and Spanish available to our kids without having to leave campus.

In addition, we have 92 juniors and seniors currently at Eastwood High School who are taking classes for college credit, plus we are working on the numbers for our students at Penta Career Center. We also have seven underclassmen that are getting a head start. All told, Eastwood students are slated to earn nearly **1,100 college credits** this year. The number is staggering, and without the hard work and dedication of our teachers, many of whom had to go back up and take 18 graduate level hours in their major over the last two summers, our students would not have this chance. That is some news worth celebrating!
