

Mini Grant Scholarships

The purpose of the Educational Mini-Grant scholarships is to support activities and projects for the benefit of the Eastwood students. Any staff member, group or organization providing services to the Eastwood School District is eligible to apply for a scholarship. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of innovation and enrichment of the educational experience of students. A committee representing the EEF will review all applications.

The Scholarships are funded through the interest earned on the mini-grant account. The Eastwood community is invited to make a donation to this account to increase the principal balance and ultimately the scholarship money awarded.

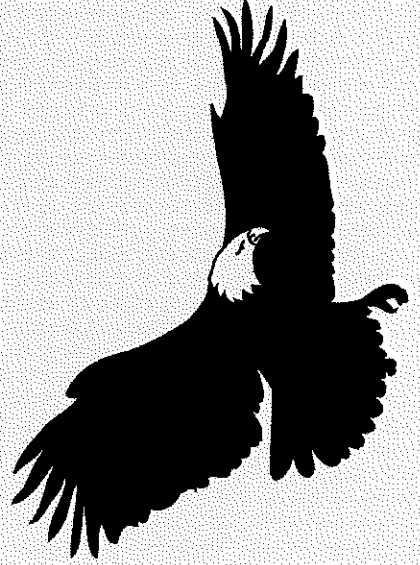
