How To Play **Quarter Frenzy!**



Each participant pays an admission fee of \$5 to gain entrance to the fundraiser event. The admission fee includes three pre-numbered paddles, which you choose after admission. Each paddle includes a chip with the matching number, which is added to the bucket to be drawn from for each item that is being auctioned (so only numbers for purchased paddles are being drawn) .



The hostess will describe the auction item along with the retail value and the number of quarters you will need to bid per paddle on the item.



You place your bid money in a container on the table and hold up your numbered paddle(s). If you would like to bid on the item with more than one paddle, you must place a bid for each paddle you would like to play. For example, if you would like to use two 2 paddles for .25 bid, you would place .50 in to play these two paddles.



When all bids are collected from the tables (by the vendors), the hostess will draw a numbered chip from the container.



If the number on your paddle matches the number on the chip drawn, you win that item. If a matching numbered paddle is not held up, the hostess calls out "No Bid" .The winner will be the next closest paddle number that was played, but does not go over the chip number that was drawn. If there are no paddles up in the air below the chip number drawn, then the winner will be the closest paddle number above the



Once a winner has been declared, all chips will be placed back in the bucket and the hostess will move on to the next item to be auctioned.

Bid Increments:

- 4 Quarter bid on – retail value of \$76 and up
- 3 Quarter bid on – retail value of \$50 – \$75
- 2 Quarter bid on – retail value of \$26 – \$49
- 1 Quarter bid on – retail value of \$ 12 – \$25

There will be an intermission half way through the raffled items and the event lasts between 2 and 3 hours
