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INSPECTOR'S STATEMENT AHERA 3-YEAR ASBESTOS REINSPECTION

This 3-year reinspection for Asbestos Containing Building Materials (ACBM) was conducted for the purpose of the re-assessment of the ACBM according to Public Law 99-519, *Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986, (AHERA).* [40CFR 763 Subpart E-763.80-763.99]

Each area of the facility was visually reinspected and reassessed to establish the condition of all friable known or assumed ACBM. Previously considered non-friable ACBM was hand touched to determine whether the material has become friable since the last inspection. Any new friable areas, which were discovered, were identified and assessed.

All of the non-friable materials, which have been assumed to contain asbestos, were found to still be in a non-friable condition. Asbestos fibers are firmly bound in these materials. Sanding, grinding, drilling, or cutting of these materials will cause asbestos fiber release. These hard materials should not be considered hazardous unless they are machined, being subjected to extensive wear, or the building is being renovated or demolished. Since these materials have been assumed to contain asbestos in accordance with the US EPA regulations, bulk sampling is recommended prior to their removal to verify the existence of asbestos in the material.

AHERA does not require roofing materials to be inspected. However, it must be assumed that all roofs may contain some form of asbestos materials. Bulk sampling should be conducted prior to any roof replacements or repairs since other regulations other than AHERA apply to the roofing materials.

This inspection report contains the following: a summary of the remaining ACBM by type and location, re-assessments and recommendations for the remaining ACBM, and the certifications of the Inspector/Management Planner.

A copy of this entire report must be included in the Main Management Plan, the applicable building sections in each school building Management Plan, and maintained indefinitely.
